Anti-Ragging Report:

An Expert talk on Anti-Ragging in Universities was given by Dean, ICFAI School of Law, Prof (Dr) Harish Kumar Verma as part of Student Orientation Program (2025-28/29) on August 21, 2025 in S -204 in ICFAI School of Liberal Arts.

Learning objectives

An expert talk on anti-ragging in universities was conducted to achieve the following learning objectives among students, faculty, and staff:

- Awareness and Understanding:
- Clearly define ragging and its various forms, including physical, psychological, verbal, and sexual abuse.
- o Explain the severe physical, psychological, and academic consequences of ragging for victims.
- Familiarize participants with the legal framework against ragging, including UGC regulations and penal provisions of the Indian Penal Code.
- Prevention and Reporting:
- Educate attendees on the importance of creating a respectful and inclusive campus environment.
- Outline the roles and responsibilities of Anti-Ragging Committees and squads in preventing and addressing ragging incidents.
- Provide information on available support systems, such as counseling services, helplines (e.g., National Anti-Ragging Helpline: 1800-180-5522), and confidential reporting mechanisms.
- Encourage students to report ragging incidents without fear, highlighting the confidentiality and protection offered to complainants.
- Promoting Positive Relationships:
- o Promote healthy senior-junior relationships based on mutual respect and empathy.
- Encourage positive interactions through mentoring programs, cultural exchanges, and other initiatives.

Session outcomes

Upon completion of the expert talk, participants took a pledge against ragging and were

expected to demonstrate the following outcomes:

• Increased Awareness: A significant increase in understanding of what constitutes ragging, its

detrimental effects, and legal ramifications.

• Empowerment to Act: Enhanced confidence among students to prevent ragging and to report

incidents without fear of retaliation.

• Commitment to a Safe Environment: A stronger commitment among all stakeholders to

creating and maintaining a ragging-free campus culture characterized by empathy, respect, and

mutual support.

• Knowledge of Support Systems: Clear awareness of the various support systems available for

students who experience or witness ragging.

• Positive Behavioural Shifts: Research indicates that such programs can potentially influence

students' perceptions and responses to ragging.

This report outlines the potential learning objectives and expected outcomes of an expert talk

on anti-ragging in universities, emphasizing the critical role of awareness, prevention, and

supportive measures in establishing a secure and empowering environment for all students.
