

Report on Door to Door Legal Aid Survey by Legal Aid and Pro Bono Club of The ICFAI University, Jaipur at Vijayapura Village, Sumel

Date: - 11th November, 2024

On 11th November 2024, the Legal Aid and Pro Bono Club of ICFAI Law School, the ICFAI University, Jaipur organized a door to door legal aid survey at Vijayapura Village, Sumel Jaipur. The aim behind this survey was to check legal awareness status in the rural area so that our club can plan further activities for promotion of legal education among villagers.

The survey began promptly at 2:30 P.M. and was led by Dr. Pratima Soni the Associate Dean of ICFAI Law School, and Mr. Ashish Acharya, Assistant Professor of Law at ICFAI Law School, Jaipur supported by the members of the Legal Aid Committee. The Primary objective of the campaign was to raise awareness about free legal aid facilities offered by DLSA and to educate villagers on how they can access these facilities to resolve their legal disputes without financial constraints. Additionally, the campaign aimed to gather information on the villager's concerns related to legal implications of the many statutory provisions.

Campaign Activities

The door-to-door legal aid survey conducted by the Legal Aid and Pro Bono Club of ICFAI Law School, Jaipur, tried to work out a meaningful step in promoting legal education among villagers. By reaching out to the villagers directly, the survey ensured that those in need of legal aid received the necessary information and support to exercise their rights. Future campaigns will be further expanded by other outreach activities and explore solutions for the specific issues raised by the villagers, contributing to a more informed and legally empowered community.
