Nesamoorthy, graced the inaugural ceremony along with Dr. Vishnu Chaudhary, the Sports Director, faculty, and students of ISLA. Day 1: Cricket

The Sports League commenced with an exciting cricket match between two teams, Divine Titans and Super Strikers.
