Dr. Subhash Sharma brings over 31 years of extensive experience as an educationist, academic administrator, and soft-skills trainer. He has earned a Ph.D. in English Literature, an MBA in Human Resource Management, and a certification in Soft Skills Training from ICFAI, Hyderabad. His doctoral research, titled “A Textual Analysis of the Non-entity in the Major Plays of Samuel Beckett,” was awarded by Rajasthan Vidyapeeth, Udaipur, in 2001.
