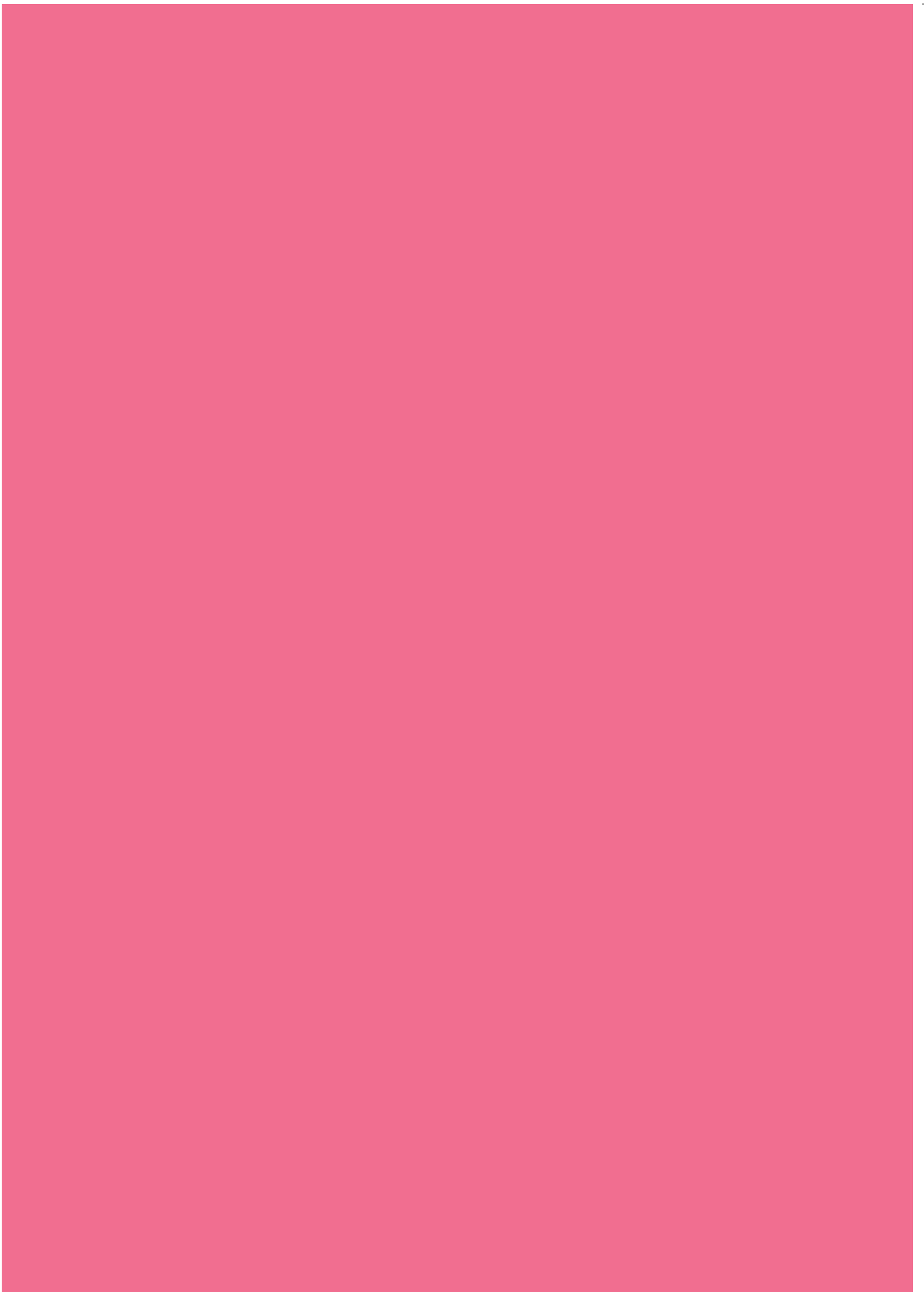

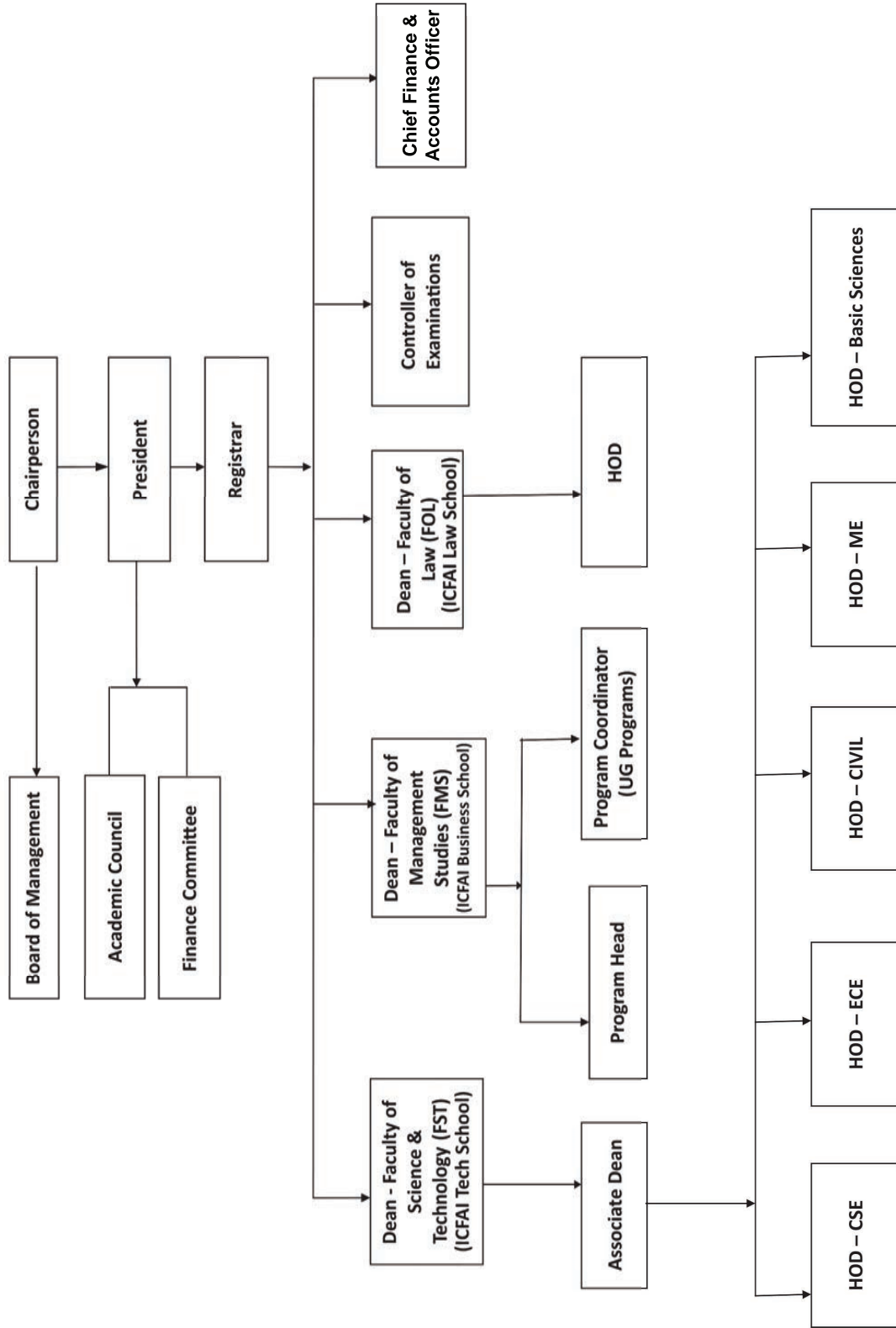
3. Governance

7. Infrastructure

The University is endowed with excellent facilities required for creating a vibrant academic atmosphere. State-of-the-art infrastructure to strengthen the academic and cultural activities is available at the University.

A. Academic Complex

The University is spread over an eco-friendly campus of 40 acres with total built up area of over 3,50,000 sq. ft. (in addition to the large basement) in the foot hills of Aravallis with spick & span classrooms, laboratories, workshops, cafeteria, student welfare facilities, sports ground, etc. The campus is Wi-Fi enabled and the library with reading room capacity of over 100 students, possesses about 17,563 books, 106 journals and 7 database.

B. Computer Facilities

The University is equipped with four Computer Labs along with Projection System catering to the needs of all faculty members. All Computers in the Labs are backed up with internet and UPS Power. Faculty Members are also provided with Computer facilities with internet connection. The entire campus is Wi-Fi enabled.

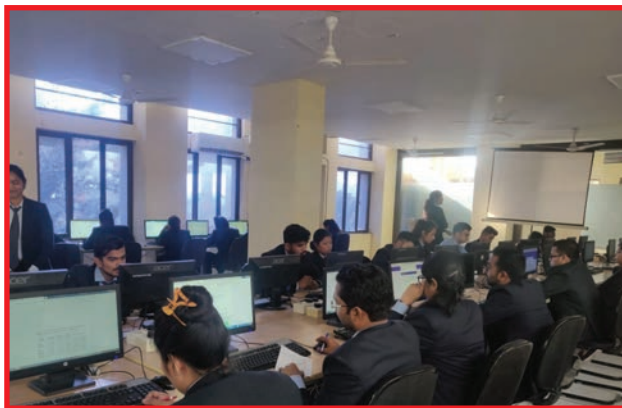

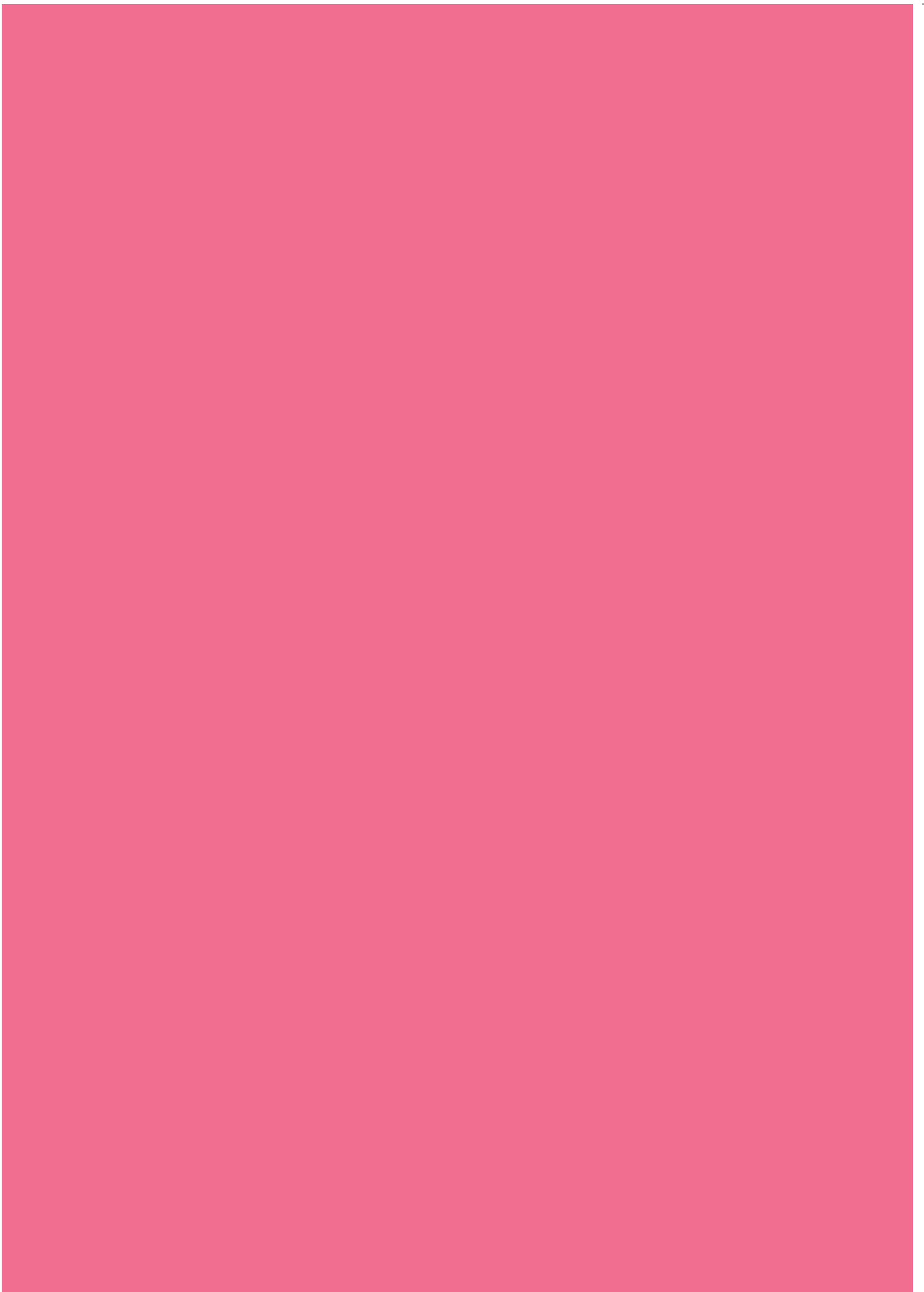
