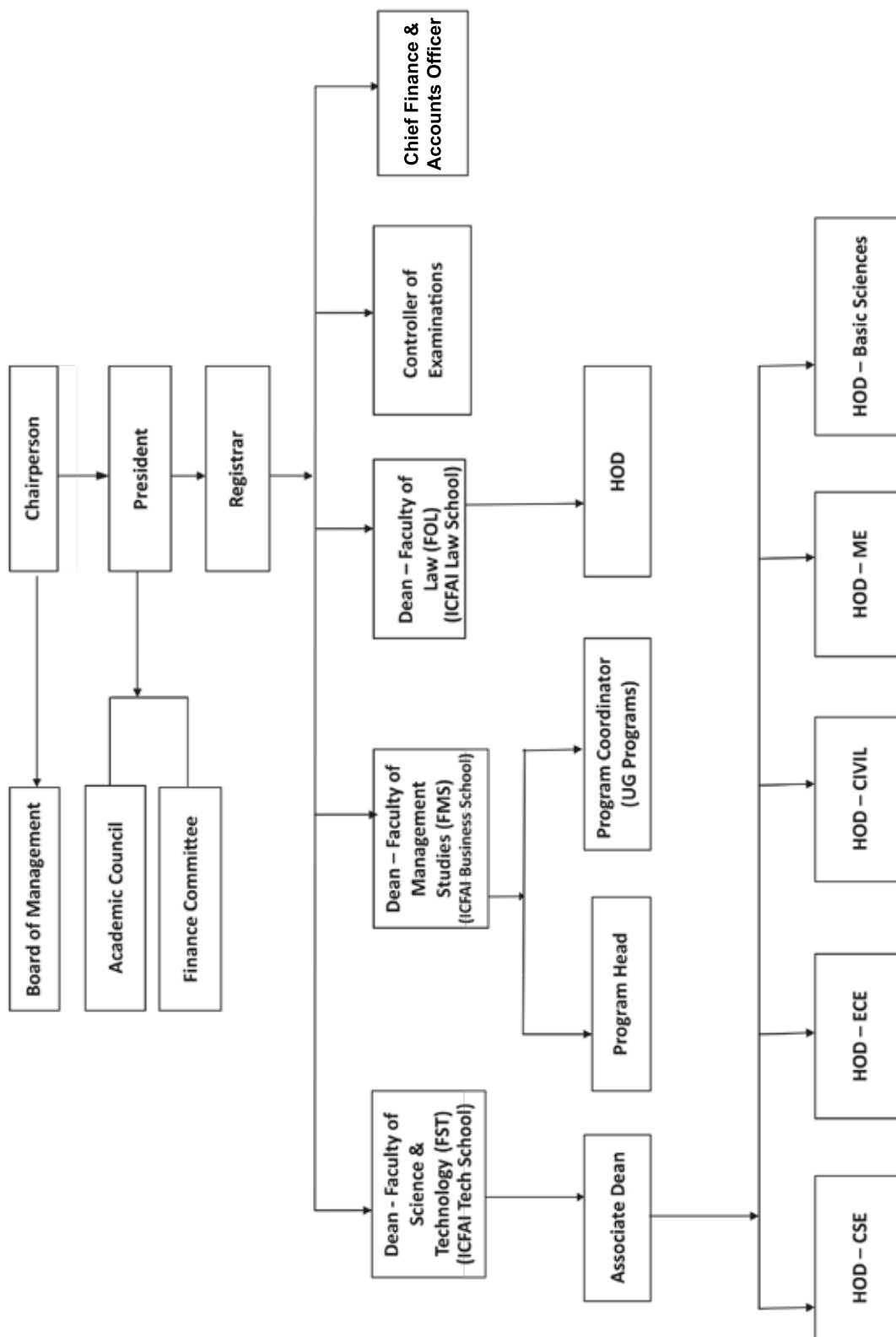
3. Governance
