2. Hon'ble President Sir has facilitated interaction with Dr. Manish Sharma, who is a NAAC Coordinator at Jaipur National University, Jaipur, to clarify the queries pertaining to the 7 criteria which arose during the collection of the data.
3. Dr. Manish briefed about the various criteria of NAAC. He elaborated upon the qualitative and quantitative aspects of various criteria. He informed that, in order to qualify for any Grade (C to A++) Institution needs to score at least 1.51 CGPA aggregate score (Qualitative and Quantitative) in each criteria. He informed that the score of Student Satisfaction Survey will not be counted at Pre Qualifier stage. However, the same would be counted at Grade Qualifier Stage. After clearing the grade qualifier the CGPA

of the institution is calculated. The CGPA will be calculated based on the scores obtained from 3 sources, viz. (a) The System Generated Score (SGS) of the Quantitative Matrix which comprises about 70% of the total, (b) The score from the qualitative, critical appraisal by the Peer Team through the onsite visit and (c) The scores obtained on the Student Satisfaction Survey, which is 30%. These will be collated through an automated procedure based on "bench mark" and assessed on a five point scale.

4. Amongst qualitative practices he emphasized upon strengthening of Curricular Aspect, Admission, Teaching Learning, Evaluation, Research, Consultancy, Extension Activities, Infrastructure, Maintenance of Infrastructure, ICT as a learning resource, Sports Activities, Student Support, Student Progression, Seminar conferences and workshop, Governance, Leadership and innovation.
5. All the 7 criteria in-charge posed the questions for clarification of doubts and Dr. Manish tried to resolve the same patiently. He emphasized upon the creation of record of every data submitted for evaluation.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair and Dr. Manish Sharma.
