## **REPORT: 2ND INTRA MEDIATION COMPETITION 2023**

On 1st February 2023, Wednesday, ADR club of ICFAI Law School, Jaipur, organised 2nd INTRA MEDIATION COMPETITION, 2023. The competition was open to students of all 5 years as well as 3 year LL.B. Total of 18 teams registered consisting of 3 members each, I.e., a client, a counsel and a mediator.
